

Überblick der Zeiten im Englischen

Zeitform	Bildung	Verwendung
<u>S.Present</u>	+ : she eats - : she doesn't eat ? : Does she eat...?	- bei regelmäßigen Handlungen, Aussagen, Feststellungen (Infozeit) - <i>sometimes, often, usually, every week/year, on Mondays,...</i>
<u>Present Progressive</u>	+ : she is eating - : she isn't eating ? : Is she eating...?	- bei Handlungen, die noch im Verlauf sind - <i>now, at the moment, at 8 o'clock, Look, ... / Listen, ...</i>
<u>Present Perfect</u>	+ : she has eaten - : she hasn't eaten ? : Has she eaten...?	- bei Handlungen, die abgeschlossen sind, deren Ergebnis aber noch in die Gegenwart reicht - <i>just, already, before, After..., since</i>
<u>Present Perfect Progressive</u>	+ : she has been eating - : she hasn't been eating ? : Has she been eating...?	- bei Handlungen, die abgeschlossen sind, deren Dauer betont wird - <i>for 3 hours, all day / all morning</i>
<u>Simple Past</u>	+ : she ate - : she didn't eat ? : Did she eat...?	- abgeschl. Handlungen (Info) der Vergangenheit, mit Zeitangabe - <i>in 1984, yesterday, last week, an hour ago,...</i>
<u>Past Progressive</u>	+ : she was eating - : she wasn't eating ? : Was she eating...?	- Verlaufshandlungen der Vergangenheit - <i>at that time, while, ...</i>
<u>Past Perfect</u>	+ : she had eaten - : she hadn't eaten ? : Had she eaten...?	- Handlungen, die zu einem Zeitpunkt der Vergangenheit bereits beendet waren - <i>before, After..., ..., since</i>
<u>Past Perfect Progressive</u>	+ : she had been eating - : she hadn't been eating ? : Had she been eating...?	- bei Handlungen der Vergangenheit, die abgeschlossen sind, deren Dauer betont wird - <i>for three hours, all morning, etc.</i>

<u>Future I</u>	+ : she will eat - : she won't eat ? : Will she eat...?	- Feststellungen in der Zukunft, spontane Pläne - <i>next week/year, tomorrow</i>
<u>Future II</u>	+ : she will have eaten - : she won't have eaten ? : Will she have eaten...?	- Handlungen, die vor einem Zeitpunkt der Zukunft bereits beendet sind - <i>after</i>
<u>Future Progressive</u>	+ : she will be eating - : she won't be eating ? : Will she be eating...?	- bei Handlungen der Zukunft, die zu einem bestimmten Zeitpunkt ablaufen werden - <i>tomorrow at seven o'clock</i>
<u>Going-to-Future</u>	+ : she is going to eat - : she isn't going to eat ? : Is she going to eat...?	- langfristige Pläne für die Zukunft
<u>Conditional I</u>	+ : she would eat - : she would eat ? : Would she eat...?	- Möglichkeitsform - <i>häufig verwendet bei If-Sätzen Typ 2 (und 3)</i>
<u>Conditional II</u>	+ : she would have eaten - : she wouldn't have eaten ? : Would she have eaten...?	- Möglichkeitsform - <i>häufig verwendet bei If-Sätzen Typ 3</i>
<u>Conditional Progressive</u>	+ : she would be eating - : she wouldn't be eating ? : Would she be eating...?	- Möglichkeitsform die zu einem bestimmten Zeitpunkt ablaufen würde
